**Details of the All India Bar Examination conducted on
July 24, 2011**

The Bar Council of India (the “**BCI**”) successfully conducted the second All India Bar Examination (the “**AIBE**”) in twenty-six cities across India on July 24, 2011. The AIBE could not be conducted at Chennai on that date.

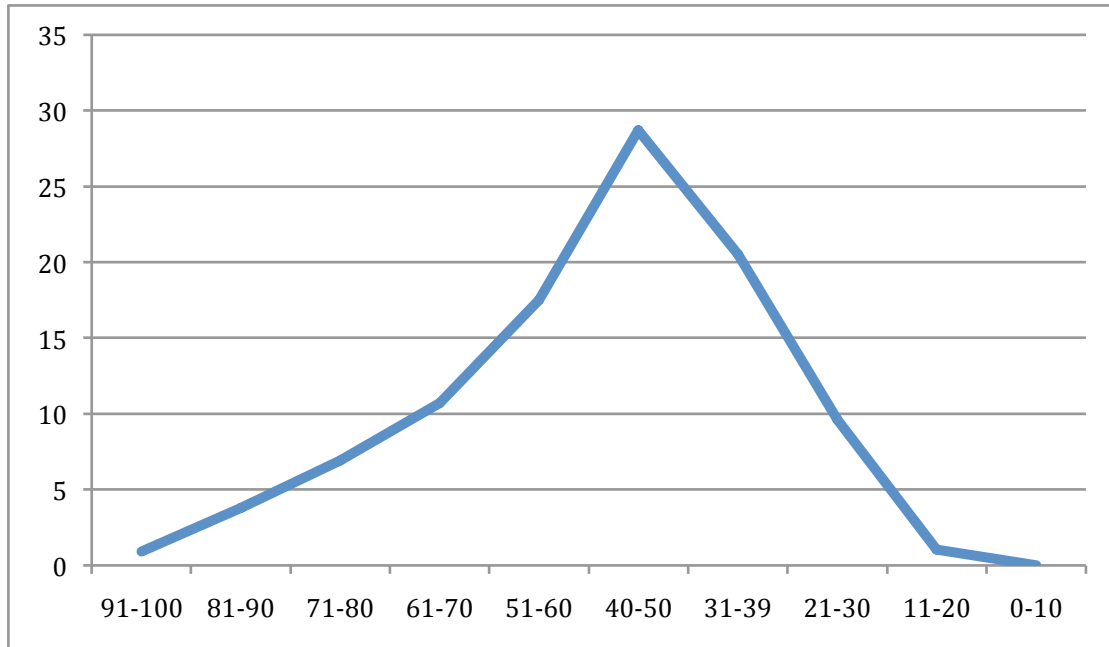
