## INSTRUCTIONS

The examination will consist of six papers covering different aspects of substantive and procedural laws essential for every legal practitioner licensed to practice law in India. The standard of examination will be that of the law courses in Universities recognized by the Bar Council of India.

The Minimum percentage of marks required to pass in each of the aforesaid papers shall be 40%.

The medium of examination shall be English. The syllabi of the aforesaid six papers is attached herewith (Annexure –I).

Each question paper shall consist of 3 parts Part – A, Part – B and Part – C.

Part – A would consist of 6 short note questions out of which candidate would need to attempt 5 questions. Each question shall carry 5 marks.

Part – B shall consist of 4 problem/analytical questions out of which candidate would need to attempt 3 questions. Each question would carry 15 marks.

Part – C shall consist of 2 essay questions out of which the candidate shall attempt one. The question would consist of two parts, one theoretical and other application based.

No books shall be allowed during any examination/papers. However, Candidates shall be permitted to use Bare Acts without notes only during papers – 4, 5 and 6. Kindly note no Bare Act/s shall be allowed for Paper 1, 2, & 3.

The candidates who have failed in any paper in the earlier examinations may appear in the forthcoming examination.

The intending candidates may apply in the prescribed form (Annexure – II) duly supported by the requisite testimonials along with three copies of passport size colour photographs. Incomplete applications shall be liable to be rejected summarily.

The last date for submission of application form for new candidates is **30<sup>th</sup> July, 2020**. If the application reaches after said date, it will be considered for the next exam.

As and when applications are received and finalized and approved, the applicant will be intimated of the requisite examination fee to be paid by such candidate by way of email. Thereafter, after deposit of the same, admit card will be emailed to the candidates by the third week of August, 2020.
