3.	Assistant Registrar(s) (2 Posts)	LL.M. or M.B.A. or Master Degree in any other stream with at least 60% marks Age limit between 35 to 40 year as on 31 st December, 2022
4.	Assistant Professor(s) (3 Posts)	LL.M. or UGC (NET) or Ph.D. as per norms of BCI and UGC with minimum of two years of experience of teaching in reputed CLE. Age limit between 32 to 38 year as on 31 st December, 2022
5.	Accounts Officer (Contractual Rs. 75000/-) (1 Post)	C.A. with experience of min 5 yrs in any reputed company/firm Age limit between 35 to 40 year as on 31 st December, 2022
6.	Librarian (Contractual Rs. 70000/-) (1 Post)	M.Lib with min 10 yrs experience of work in Supreme Court, any High Court or any Centre of Legal Education Age limit between 35 to 40 year as on 31 st December, 2022

Note:

It is made clear that BCI Trust-PEARL FIRST is an independent body and is not under the control of BCI and the appointees shall not be treated to be the employees of the BCI.

The Trust reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of vacancies Or to cancel the Advertisement notice Or to make any other changes in the qualifications/eligibility criteria (suitable in the opinion of Selection Committee or the Trust) anytime without assigning any reason .

- (A) Contractual appointments are valid for a period of 1 year only (from the date of joining). If the contracts are not renewed by the management the appointments/engagements shall be automatically deemed to be terminated. No specific order shall be required for such termination(s).
- (B) The basic salary of Joint Director (s) would be Rs. 78,800/- (which will be at par with Joint Secretary of Bar Council of India) and the basic salary of Assistant Registrar would be Rs. 67,700/- (which will be at par with the emolument of Assistant Secretary of Bar Council of India). The emoluments of Assistant Registrars would be decided by the Board depending on the merit & performance, experience etc. Of the candidates.
- (C) The appointees(Sl. No. 1 to 9) may be posted/required to work either at Delhi or Goa, or anywhere in India or abroad.

The Director (Legal), if expresses his desire to work for the Institution and simultaneously to continue with the Legal Profession (at Delhi Supreme Court of Delhi High Court), he may express his desire to the selection committee to work as Honorary Joint Director (only for the present) the selection committee may make suitable recommendation, as it thinks fit and proper. Such expression of desire has to be made at the time of interview in writing only. Trust is to take final decision in this regard.


The candidates shall be required to appear for a written test and the Interview. Selection will be made through a Selection Committee as decided by the Board of Trustees.

The final selection will be made on the basis of overall performance and suitability of the candidates. A candidate shall have to secure a minimum of 80% marks in written test and 80% interview separately.

The decision of the Bar Council of India Trust-(PEARL-FIRST) shall be final in the matter of Selection/ Appointment. Merely because of selection, no right shall be accrued to any one for appointment.

Only short-listed candidates will be called for the written Test and/or Interview. The Selection/ /Screening/Shortlisting cannot be questioned by the candidates. Please note that the selection shall not give any right of appointment to anyone.
